The Peter Cane Prize for Legal Reasoning for an Aspiring Lawyer

With a first prize of up to £175, this prize gives entrants a legal case to consider and to respond to in no more than 2,000 words. The prize asks entrants to engage with four key parts of legal reasoning: 'Understand. Analyse. Communicate. Persuade.'
